Time Sensitive Notice! Register your professional development conference, course, or event now for Oregon's Teacher Professional Improvement Inservice Day on October 14, 2011. The Oregon Teacher Inservice Bulletin is distributed statewide, and includes events for Inservice Day, and for other dates throughout the school year. [The deadline is August 20.](#)

Distribution: The bulletin will be mailed around September 1 to each school district, and to the principal of each public and private school in the state, as shown on the current ODE mail list. Listed professional development providers can view their listing at any time at <http://www.youthchg.com/oregon.html>. Other educational organizations will be encouraged to also post and distribute the bulletin.

Listing Information: Please use this [registration form \(click\)](#) to sign up event. Programs designed to assist in classroom-appropriate activities are eligible. Your entry may be edited as necessary due to space limitations. You are welcome to list professional development events taking place at times other than Inservice Day.

Deadline: To guarantee inclusion in the printed bulletin, your submission must arrive by August 20. Submissions received after that date will be accepted on a space-available basis, at extra cost. Listing fees must be paid prior to inclusion. Listings will be accepted at any time for inclusion on the online version of the bulletin; and will be charged a reduced rate.

Fee: To cover the costs of compiling, preparing, reproducing and distributing the bulletin, there is a fee of \$85 for each entry, and \$50 for website-only listings.

Other Details: The bulletin was created by the Oregon Dept. of Education more than 25 years ago, and has been at the center of Inservice Day ever since. A non-profit has been the publisher of the bulletin for past 21 years, but in early July, 2011, it appeared that group had ceased to exist, and that no inservice schedule would be published. To prevent the loss of a critical Oregon education tradition, Youth Change Workshops decided to re-create the bulletin. Youth Change has been listed in the bulletin for decades, and will attempt to duplicate all aspects of the publication as it has historically existed. Youth Change is a 22 year-old, Oregon-based, national K-12 educator training group that also publishes books, posters, and other resources.
