




INTRODUCTION

Breakout Workshop #1

Control the Uncontrollable Student





Workshop #6

The Best Negativity and Apathy-Busters

Negative attitudes and apathy may be commonplace among students, but staff training seldom includes extensive, practical preparation to stop and manage these concerns. Powerful, effective interventions do exist to prevent or modify the negative attitudes and rampant apathy, and these must-have methods are packed into this workshop. 


